The top section displays student name, class, enrollment date, and OSIS number for the current school year.

The "i-Ready Goal" is set based on the student's original diagnostic. The "Growth Achieved" is how much growth the student showed on the next two assessments throughout the year. The results of all 3 assessments are shown in the bar graphs below.

NWEA is an assessment that uses a national norm percentile (shown in the bar graph Key) comparing the student's score to all other students across the country in their grade level.

Running Record is a reading assessment given three times to each student. The goal for each student is to be "on grade level", displayed in parentheses in the heading next to "Running Record". The results of the student's three assessments are shown in the bar graphs below, with each result labeled below the bar.

Lexile Level (Grades 1-5 only) is based on the ELA portion of the i-Ready diagnostic. It is a measure of the student's ability to comprehend the text's difficulty. The goal for each student is to be "on grade level", displayed in parentheses in the heading next to "Lexile Level". A negative score indicates the student is a "Beginning Reader", often times seen in first grade students.

Writing Assessment is an in-house assessment given three times per year based on a 16-point rubric. The goal is for each student to improve upon their original score as the school year progresses, indicating a growth in writing abilities. Each rubric is designed to match the student's individual grade level.

State Test (grades 3-5 only) is a New York State mandated test given each spring students in grades 3 through 5 in both ELA and Math. Students are given a performance level on a scale from 1 to 4. For the current school, the state will release the performance levels in September. For students in grades 4 and 5, previous year's performance levels are displayed.

The bottom section displays additional student information relevant to their academic and social/emotional education at CMCCS.
